Because, it is declared throughout the Word of God.

This is how it begins:

Romans 10:9-10 (NLT) If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. **10** For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved.

1 John 5:11-14 (NLT) And this is what God has testified: He has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. **12** Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have God's Son does not have life. **13** I have written this to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know you have eternal life. **14** And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him.

Acts 13:38-39 (NLT) "Brothers, listen! We are here to proclaim that through this man Jesus there is forgiveness for your sins. **39** Everyone who believes in him is declared right with God—something the law of Moses could never do.

Psalms 103:3 (NLT) He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases.

Psalms 130:3-5 (NLT) LORD, if you kept a record of our sins, who, O Lord, could ever survive? **4** But you offer forgiveness, that we might learn to fear you. **5** I am counting on the LORD; yes, I am counting on him. I have put my hope in his word.

1 John 4:13 (NLT) And God has given us his Spirit as proof that we live in him and he in us.

Romans 8:16 (NLT) For his Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children.

Galatians 4:6 (NLT) And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, "Abba, Father."

God even cleanses our consciences

Romans 8:1 (NLT) So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus.

1 John 3:20 (NKJV) For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things.

God even cleanses our consciences

Hebrews 10:22 (NLT) let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts fully trusting him. For our guilty consciences have been sprinkled with Christ's blood to make us clean, and our bodies have been washed with pure water.

1 John 2:3 (NLT) And we can be sure that we know him if we obey his commandments.

Obedience is such a part of our relationship with Jesus

1 John 3:19 (NLT) Our actions will show that we belong to the truth, so we will be confident when we stand before God.

Matthew 6:14(NLT) "If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you.

Ephesians 1:3-8 (NLT) All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ. ⁴ Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes. ⁵ God decided in advance to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure. ⁶ So we praise God for the glorious grace he has poured out on us who belong to his dear Son. ⁷ He is so rich in kindness and grace that he purchased our freedom with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins. ⁸ He has showered his kindness on us, along with all wisdom and understanding.

1 John 1:9 (NLT) But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.

Psalms 103:12 (New Living Translation) He has removed our sins as far from us as the east is from the west.

Acts 26:17b-20 Yes, I am sending you to the Gentiles ¹⁸ to open their eyes, so they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God. Then they will receive forgiveness for their sins and be given a place among God's people, who are set apart by faith in me.' ¹⁹ "And so, King Agrippa, I obeyed that vision from heaven. ²⁰ I preached first to those in Damascus, then in Jerusalem and throughout all Judea, and also to the Gentiles, that all must repent of their sins and turn to God—and prove they have changed by the good things they do.

2 Corinthians 7:1 (NLT) Because we have these promises, dear friends, let us cleanse ourselves from everything that can defile our body or spirit. And let us work toward complete holiness because we fear God.

Colossians 2:11-14 (NLT) When you came to Christ, you were “circumcised,” but not by a physical procedure. Christ performed a spiritual circumcision—the cutting away of your sinful nature. ¹² For you were buried with Christ when you were baptized. And with him you were raised to new life because you trusted the mighty power of God, who raised Christ from the dead. ¹³ You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins. ¹⁴ He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.

When the devil attempts to lie to you about being forgiven remind him it has been nailed to the cross.
