PRAYER FOCUS : Physical or emotional healing.

Prayer Points:

- Jesus thank you that through the sacrifice you made, we can come before God believing that you will heal us and use us to heal those around us.
- God we pray that we would see clearly the opportunities you give us in our daily lives. Help us to remove the blinders that hinder us from seeing as you see in order to see more clearly your divine encounters that you have set for each of us.
- According to Luke 12:12, Holy Spirit lead us and give us the words to speak at the appropriate times to cut right to the heart, to hear your whisper exactly to what their need is that you want to meet.
- Increase our faith and give us boldness to step out and reach out to those who you send across our paths.

Scriptures:

- Compassion - Matthew 14:14 – And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.
- Faith - Mark 11:22-24 – So Jesus answered and said to them, “Have faith in God. For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*”
- Our Authority through Jesus - Mark 16:18 – ...they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”
- God’s Power, not ours - Zechariah 4:6 – Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,’ Says the LORD of hosts
- God’s Power - Luke 9:1-2 – Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.
- Faith - John 14:13 You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it...
- Faith glorifies God - John 15:7-8 – If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit
- Pray - James 5:16 – Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

WE are God’s hands, WE are God’s feet, WE are the body of Christ on the earth! That means WE are whom God is using to go out and touch each and every one of his children.

Look at the scriptures, meditate on the scriptures, see what Jesus has given us through his death and resurrection and what he is counting on us to do for him on this Earth. Pray for one another that we may be healed. Believe that nothing is impossible with God, (Luke 1:37). Realize and exercise the authority that we have through Jesus and his blood. Preach his word and pray for the sick. Lay hands on the sick believing that they will recover. See the lost through Jesus’ eyes, see them with the compassion he had. Have FAITH in the word.

Expect God to perform great and mighty things as you step out in faith! The harvest is out there, we are the harvest workers, and God’s counting on you and I to reach out to His lost children and bring them in. He’s provided us everything, we need to do what He wants us to do.

Action Step:

- Be open to the leading of the Holy Spirit in your day-to-day life. Listen for the whisper to reach out to a stranger and ask them if you can pray for them. Be open to hearing the Holy Spirit give you a word of wisdom or a word of knowledge regarding someone He’s directing you to.
